A BILL

To repeal the reduced annual cost-of-living adjustment of the retired pay of retired members of the Armed Forces under the age of 62 imposed by the Bipartisan Budget Act of 2013.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “America First Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. REPEAL OF REDUCED ANNUAL COST-OF-LIVING AD-**
2 **JUSTMENT OF THE RETIRED PAY OF RE-**
3 **TIRED MEMBERS OF THE ARMED FORCES**
4 **UNDER THE AGE OF 62.**

5 (a) REPEAL.—Section 403 of the Bipartisan Budget
6 Act of 2013 (Public Law 113–67), section 10001 of the
7 Department of Defense Appropriations Act, 2014 (Public
8 Law 113–76), and sections 1 and 2 of Public Law 113–
9 82 are repealed.

10 (b) OFFSETTING REDUCTION IN FOREIGN AID.—To
11 offset the costs to be incurred by the amendments made
12 by subsection (a), the amounts otherwise authorized to be
13 appropriated for foreign aid (including non-military and
14 military assistance) for each of fiscal years 2015 through
15 2024 shall be reduced by \$600,000,000.
