A BILL

To amend the VOW to Hire Heroes Act of 2011 to extend the Veterans Retraining Assistance Program, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the "Help Hire our Heroes
5 Act".

1 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF VETERANS RETRAINING ASSIST-**
2 **ANCE PROGRAM.**

3 Section 211 of the VOW to Hire Heroes Act of 2011
4 (Public Law 112–56; 38 U.S.C. 4100 note) is amended—

5 (1) in subsection (a)(2)(B), by striking “March
6 31” and inserting “September 30”; and

7 (2) in subsection (k), by striking “March 31”
8 and inserting “September 30”.

9 **SEC. 3. TRANSFER FROM LEAKING UNDERGROUND STOR-**
10 **AGE TANK TRUST FUND TO VETERANS RE-**
11 **TRAINING ASSISTANCE PROGRAM.**

12 Subsection (c) of section 9508 of the Internal Rev-
13 enue Code of 1986 is amended by adding at the end the
14 following new paragraph:

15 “(3) TRANSFER TO DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS
16 AFFAIRS.—Out of amounts in the Leaking Under-
17 ground Storage Tank Trust Fund there is hereby
18 appropriated \$270,000,000 to be transferred to the
19 ‘Veterans Benefits Administration—Readjustment
20 Benefits’ account of the Department of Veterans Af-
21 fairs for the Veterans Retraining Assistance Pro-
22 gram under section 211 of the VOW to Hire Heroes
23 Act of 2011 (Public Law 112–56; 38 U.S.C. 4100
24 note), to remain available until expended.”.
