Mr. ROGERS of Kentucky (for himself and Mrs. LOWEY) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Appropriations, and in addition to the Committee on Foreign Affairs, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned

A BILL

To provide for the costs of loan guarantees for Ukraine.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PROVISION OF COSTS OF LOAN GUARANTEES**

4 **FOR UKRAINE.**

5 From amounts appropriated or otherwise made avail-
6 able under “Economic Support Fund” in division K of the
7 Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2014 (Public Law 113–
8 76), and prior Acts making appropriations for the Depart-
9 ment of State, foreign operations, and related programs,
10 funding from unobligated balances shall be made available

1 for the costs, as defined in section 502 of the Congres-
2 sional Budget Act of 1974, of loan guarantees for
3 Ukraine, which are authorized to be provided in an appro-
4 priations Act, in accordance with section 504 of the Con-
5 gressional Budget Act of 1974: *Provided*, That amounts
6 made available for the costs of such guarantees shall not
7 be considered “assistance” for the purpose of provisions
8 of law limiting assistance to such country: *Provided fur-*
9 *ther*, That none of the funds may be made available from
10 amounts designated pursuant to section 251(b)(2)(A) of
11 the Balanced Budget and Emergency Deficit Control Act
12 of 1985.
