A BILL

To permanently withdraw, reserve, and transfer Bureau of Land Management lands used for military purposes in Alaska, Nevada, and New Mexico to the appropriate Secretary of the military department concerned.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ELIMINATION OF TERMINATION DATE.**

4 (a) SHORT TITLE.—This Act may be cited as the
5 “Bureau of Land Management Withdrawn Military Lands
6 Efficiency and Savings Act”.

1 (b) IN GENERAL.—Section 3015(a) of the Military
2 Lands Withdrawal Act of 1999 (Public Law 106–65) is
3 amended by striking “shall” the first place it appears and
4 all that follows through the period and inserting “shall not
5 terminate other than by an election and determination of
6 the Secretary of the military department concerned or
7 until such time as the Secretary of the Interior can perma-
8 nently transfer administrative jurisdiction of the lands
9 withdrawn and reserved by this Act to the Secretary of
10 the military department concerned.”.

11 (c) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section 3016 of the
12 Military Lands Withdrawal Act of 1999 (Public Law 106–
13 65) is repealed.
