A BILL

To amend the Public Health Service Act to reauthorize the
Emergency Medical Services for Children Program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 *This Act may be cited as the “Wakefield Act of 2014”.*

5 **SEC. 2. REAUTHORIZATION OF EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERV-**
6 **ICES FOR CHILDREN PROGRAM.**

7 *Section 1910(d) of the Public Health Service Act (42*
8 *U.S.C. 300w–9(d)) is amended by striking “fiscal year*
9 *2014” and inserting “each of fiscal years 2015 through*
10 *2019”.*

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
