A BILL

To remove a use restriction on land formerly a part of Acadia National Park that was transferred to the town of Tremont, Maine, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. USE RESTRICTION REMOVED.**

4 The Act entitled “An Act to authorize the convey-
5 ance, for school purposes, of certain land in Acadia Na-
6 tional Park to the town of Tremont, Maine, and for other
7 purposes”, approved August 1, 1950, is amended by add-
8 ing at the end the following: “Lands conveyed to the town
9 of Tremont, Maine, under the Act known as NPS Tract
10 06–126, which were conveyed by the National Park Serv-
11 ice in deed recorded at the Hancock County Registry of
12 Deeds Book 737 Page 467, National Park Service Deed
13 377, shall no longer be required to be used exclusively and
14 perpetually for school purposes and upon the discontinu-
15 ance of such use of said land, or any part thereof, shall
16 no longer be required to revert to the United States.”.
