1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. BROOKWOOD-SAGO MINE SAFETY GRANTS.**

4 Section 14(g) of the Mine Improvement and New
5 Emergency Response Act of 2006 (30 U.S.C. 965(g)) is
6 amended—

1 (1) by striking “There are” and inserting “(1)
2 IN GENERAL.—There are”; and

3 (2) by adding at the end the following:

4 “(2) SPECIFIC PROGRAMS AUTHORIZATION.—In
5 addition to amounts authorized under paragraph
6 (1), there is authorized to be appropriated
7 \$4,000,000 for fiscal year 2015 specifically for
8 grants providing hands-on mine safety skills training
9 and certification in mine rescue and mine emergency
10 response.”.
