SECTION 1. REPORT ON ENERGY AND WATER SAVINGS PO-2 TENTIAL FROM THERMAL INSULATION. 3 (a) Report.—Not later than 1 year after the date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Energy, in con-4 5 sultation with appropriate Federal agencies and relevant stakeholders, shall submit to the Committee on Energy 6 7 and Natural Resources of the Senate and the Committee 8 on Energy and Commerce of the House of Representatives 9 a report on the impact of thermal insulation on both en-10 ergy and water use systems for potable hot and chilled water in Federal buildings, and the return on investment 11 of installing such insulation. 12

- (b) CONTENTS.—The report shall include—
- 14 (1) an analysis based on the cost of municipal 15 or regional water for delivered water and the avoided 16 cost of new water; and
- 17 (2) a summary of energy and water savings, in-18 cluding short term and long term (20 years) projec-19 tions of such savings.
