A BILL

To recognize a primary measure of national unemployment
for purposes of the Federal Government.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Real Unemployment
5 Calculation Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. PRIMARY MEASURE OF UNEMPLOYMENT.**

7 The measure of unemployment issued by the Bureau
8 of Labor Statistics known as U5 shall be treated by the
9 Bureau as the official unemployment rate and shall be

1 considered by the Federal Government as the primary
2 measure of unemployment in the United States.
