A BILL

To prevent the expansion of the Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals program unlawfully created by Executive memorandum on August 15, 2012.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. LIMITATION ON DEFERRED ACTION FOR**
4 **CHILDHOOD ARRIVALS; RESTRICTIONS ON**
5 **EMPLOYMENT AUTHORIZATION FOR ALIENS**
6 **NOT IN LAWFUL STATUS.**

7 No agency or instrumentality of the Federal Govern-
8 ment may use Federal funding or resources—

9 (1) to consider or adjudicate any new or pre-
10 viously denied application of any alien requesting

1 consideration of deferred action for childhood arriv-
2 als, as authorized by Executive memorandum on Au-
3 gust 15, 2012; or

4 (2) to authorize any alien to work in the United
5 States if such alien—

6 (A) was not lawfully admitted into the
7 United States in compliance with the Immigra-
8 tion and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1101 et
9 seq.); and

10 (B) is not in lawful status in the United
11 States on the date of the enactment of this Act.
