## AN ACT

To reauthorize the Young Women's Breast Health Education  
and Awareness Requires Learning Young Act of 2009.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “EARLY Act Reauthor-  
3 ization of 2014”.

4 **SEC. 2. REAUTHORIZATION OF THE YOUNG WOMEN’S**  
5 **BREAST HEALTH EDUCATION AND AWARE-**  
6 **NESS REQUIRES LEARNING YOUNG ACT OF**  
7 **2009.**

8 Section 399NN(h) of the Public Health Service Act  
9 (42 U.S.C. 280m(h)) is amended by striking “\$9,000,000  
10 for each of the fiscal years 2010 through 2014” and in-  
11 serting “\$4,900,000 for each of fiscal years 2015 through  
12 2019”.

13 **SEC. 3. GAO REPORT ON HHS ACTIVITIES TO PROVIDE**  
14 **BREAST CANCER EDUCATION.**

15 Not later than 2 years after the date of enactment  
16 of this Act, the Comptroller General of the United States  
17 shall submit to the appropriate committees of the Con-  
18 gress a report—

19 (1) listing and detailing the activities of the De-  
20 partment of Health and Human Services that pro-  
21 vide or support breast cancer education described in  
22 subsection (a), (b), (c), or (d) of section 399NN of  
23 the Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 280m);  
24 and

1           (2) identifying any such activities that are du-  
2           plicative with each other or with other Federal  
3           breast cancer education efforts.
