1 **SECTION 1. NO PAY ADJUSTMENT FOR MEMBERS OF CON-**
2 **GRESS DURING ONE HUNDRED THIRTEENTH**
3 **CONGRESS.**

4 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, no ad-
5 justment shall be made under section 601(a) of the Legis-
6 lative Reorganization Act of 1946 (2 U.S.C. 31), relating
7 to compensation of Members of Congress, with respect to
8 any pay period occurring during the One Hundred Thir-
9 tenth Congress.
