RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2575) to amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to repeal the 30-hour threshold for classification as a full-time employee for purposes of the employer mandate in the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act and replace it with 40 hours.

- 1 *Resolved*, That upon adoption of this resolution it
- 2 shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R.
- 3 2575) to amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to

1 repeal the 30-hour threshold for classification as a full-
2 time employee for purposes of the employer mandate in
3 the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act and re-
4 place it with 40 hours. All points of order against consid-
5 eration of the bill are waived. The amendment in the na-
6 ture of a substitute recommended by the Committee on
7 Ways and Means now printed in the bill shall be consid-
8 ered as adopted. The bill, as amended, shall be considered
9 as read. All points of order against provisions in the bill,
10 as amended, are waived. The previous question shall be
11 considered as ordered on the bill, as amended, and on any
12 amendment thereto to final passage without intervening
13 motion except: (1) three hours of debate equally divided
14 and controlled by the chair and ranking minority member
15 of the Committee on Ways and Means; and (2) one motion
16 to recommit with or without instructions.

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
