RESOLUTION

Relating to the application of Article II, section 3, clause
5, of the Constitution of the United States.

1 *Resolved*, That the Secretary of the Treasury has
2 failed to meet the requirement of Article II, section 3,
3 clause 5, of the Constitution of the United States to take
4 care that a law be faithfully executed, with respect to the
5 policy of the Department of the Treasury pertaining to
6 the 1-year delay in the application of the reporting re-
7 quirements of sections 6055 and 6056 of the Internal Rev-
8 enue Code of 1986 (and related requirements of section
9 4980H of such Code), as provided under Department of

1 the Treasury Notice 2013–45, as announced by the De-
2 partment of the Treasury on July 2, 2013; and that the
3 House of Representatives shall bring a civil action in the
4 United States District Court for the District of Columbia
5 for declaratory or injunctive relief to challenge the policy
6 of the Department of the Treasury.
