Ms. WILSON of Florida submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Rules

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2821) to provide tax relief for American workers and businesses, to put workers back on the job while rebuilding and modernizing America, and to provide pathways back to work for Americans looking for jobs.

1 *Resolved*, That immediately upon adoption of this res-
2 olution the Speaker shall, pursuant to clause 2(b) of rule
3 XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee of
4 the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 2821) to provide tax relief for
6 American workers and businesses, to put workers back on
7 the job while rebuilding and modernizing America, and to

1 provide pathways back to work for Americans looking for
2 jobs. All points of order against consideration of the bill
3 are waived. General debate shall be confined to the bill
4 and shall not exceed one hour equally divided and con-
5 trolled by the chair and ranking minority member of the
6 Committee on Ways and Means. After general debate the
7 bill shall be considered for amendment under the five-
8 minute rule. Each section of the bill shall be considered
9 as read. All points of order against provisions in the bill
10 are waived. At the conclusion of consideration of the bill
11 for amendment the Committee shall rise and report the
12 bill to the House with such amendments as may have been
13 adopted. The previous question shall be considered as or-
14 dered on the bill and amendments thereto to final passage
15 without intervening motion except one motion to recommit
16 with or without instructions. If the Committee of the
17 Whole rises and reports that it has come to no resolution
18 on the bill, then on the next legislative day the House
19 shall, immediately after the third daily order of business
20 under clause 1 of rule XIV, resolve into the Committee
21 of the Whole for further consideration of the bill.

22 SEC. 2. Clause 1(c) of rule XIX shall not apply to
23 the consideration of H.R. 2821.
