## RESOLUTION

Expressing the sense of the House of Representatives that there be support for a referendum on the independence of the Kurdish region of Iraq.

1       *Resolved*, That it is the sense of the House of Rep-  
2       resentatives that—

3               (1) there should be a referendum by the  
4       Kurdistan Regional Government of Iraq to deter-  
5       mine whether Kurdistan should become an inde-  
6       pendent and sovereign country by its people; and

1           (2) the United States Government should recog-  
2           nize and abide by the results of such a referendum.
