A BILL

To direct the Secretary of the Interior to install in the area of the World War II Memorial in the District of Columbia a suitable plaque or an inscription with the words that President Franklin D. Roosevelt prayed with the United States on D-Day, June 6, 1944.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “World War II Memo-
3 rial Prayer Act of 2013”.

4 **SEC. 2. PLACEMENT OF PLAQUE OR INSCRIPTION AT**
5 **WORLD WAR II MEMORIAL.**

6 The Secretary of the Interior—

7 (1) shall install in the area of the World War
8 II Memorial in the District of Columbia a suitable
9 plaque or an inscription with the words that Presi-
10 dent Franklin D. Roosevelt prayed with the United
11 States on June 6, 1944, the morning of D-Day;

12 (2) shall design, procure, prepare, and install
13 the plaque or inscription referred to in paragraph
14 (1); and

15 (3) may not use Federal funds to prepare or in-
16 stall the plaque or inscription referred to in para-
17 graph (1), but may accept and expend private con-
18 tributions for this purpose.

19 **SEC. 3. COMMEMORATIVE WORKS ACT.**

20 Chapter 89 of title 40, United States Code (com-
21 monly known as the “Commemorative Works Act”), shall
22 apply to the design and placement of the plaque within
23 the area of the World War II Memorial.

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
