3 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
4 Postal Service located at 130 Caldwell Drive in
5 Hazlehurst, Mississippi, shall be known and designated as
6 the “First Lieutenant Alvin Chester Cockrell, Jr. Post Of-
7 fice Building”.

8 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
9 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
10 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
11 be deemed to be a reference to the “First Lieutenant Alvin
12 Chester Cockrell, Jr. Post Office Building”.

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
