AN ACT

To amend the Controlled Substances Act to allow a veterinarian to transport and dispense controlled substances in the usual course of veterinary practice outside of the registered location.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. TRANSPORTING AND DISPENSING CON-**
2 **TROLLED SUBSTANCES IN THE USUAL**
3 **COURSE OF VETERINARY PRACTICE.**

4 Section 302(e) of the Controlled Substances Act (21
5 U.S.C. 822(e)) is amended—

6 (1) by striking “(e)” and inserting “(e)(1)”;

7 and

8 (2) by adding at the end the following:

9 “(2) Notwithstanding paragraph (1), a registrant
10 who is a veterinarian shall not be required to have a sepa-
11 rate registration in order to transport and dispense con-
12 trolled substances in the usual course of veterinary prac-
13 tice at a site other than the registrant’s registered prin-
14 cipal place of business or professional practice, so long as
15 the site of transporting and dispensing is located in a
16 State where the veterinarian is licensed to practice veteri-
17 nary medicine and is not a principal place of business or
18 professional practice.”.
