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## A BILL

To ensure that the personal and private information of Americans enrolling in Exchanges established under the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act is secured with proper privacy and data security safeguards.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Trust But Verify Act”  
5 or the “PIN Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROTECTION OF HEALTH INFORMATION.**

2       Notwithstanding any other provision of law, an Amer-  
3 ican Health Benefit Exchange shall not offer health insur-  
4 ance coverage through the Exchange until the date on  
5 which the Comptroller General of the United States in  
6 consultation with the Department of Health and Human  
7 Services Office of the Inspector General submits to Con-  
8 gress a certification that finds that the Department of  
9 Health and Human Services, and any related Federal  
10 agencies involved in the administration of such Exchanges,  
11 have implemented all appropriate actions necessary to  
12 safeguard the personal health and financial information  
13 of enrollees and to properly protect enrollees from fraud  
14 and abuse.

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
