A BILL

To allow for the harvest of gull eggs by the Huna Tlingit
people within Glacier Bay National Park in the State
of Alaska.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Huna Tlingit Tradi-
5 tional Gull Egg Use Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. AUTHORIZATION FOR COLLECTION OF GULL EGGS.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
8 sion of law, the Secretary of the Interior may allow the
9 collection of the eggs of glaucous-winged gulls (*Larus*
10 *glaucescens*) not more frequently than twice each calendar

1 year at up to 5 locations within Glacier Bay National Park
2 in the State of Alaska by members of the Hoonah Indian
3 Association.

4 (b) CONDITIONS.—The Secretary of the Interior shall
5 establish harvest schedules and locations and any other
6 terms and conditions the Secretary determines to be nec-
7 essary, based on an annual harvest plan to be prepared
8 jointly by the Secretary and the Hoonah Indian Associa-
9 tion.
