A BILL

To preserve and protect the free choice of individual employees to form, join, or assist labor organizations, or to refrain from such activities.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “National Right-to-
5 Work Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENTS TO THE NATIONAL LABOR RELA-**
 2 **TIONS ACT.**

3 (a) RIGHTS OF EMPLOYEES.—Section 7 of the Na-
 4 tional Labor Relations Act (29 U.S.C. 157) is amended
 5 by striking “except to” and all that follows through “au-
 6 thorized in section 8(a)(3)”.

7 (b) UNFAIR LABOR PRACTICES.—Section 8 of the
 8 National Labor Relations Act (29 U.S.C. 158) is amend-
 9 ed—

10 (1) in subsection (a)(3), by striking “: Pro-
 11 vided, That” and all that follows through “retaining
 12 membership”;

13 (2) in subsection (b)—

14 (A) in paragraph (2), by striking “or to
 15 discriminate” and all that follows through “re-
 16 taining membership”; and

17 (B) in paragraph (5), by striking “covered
 18 by an agreement authorized under subsection
 19 (a)(3) of this section”; and

20 (3) in subsection (f), by striking clause (2) and
 21 redesignating clauses (3) and (4) as clauses (2) and
 22 (3), respectively.

23 **SEC. 3. AMENDMENT TO THE RAILWAY LABOR ACT.**

24 Section 2 of the Railway Labor Act (45 U.S.C. 152)
 25 is amended by striking paragraph Eleven.
