## A BILL

To prohibit bonuses to senior-level IRS executives until all Congressional requests for documents, including electronic communications, related to the investigation of IRS targeting of taxpayers are complete.

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2        *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3        **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4        This Act may be cited as the “Holding the IRS Lead-  
5        ership Accountable Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON BONUSES UNTIL IRS COMPLIES**  
2 **WITH CONGRESSIONAL DOCUMENT RE-**  
3 **QUESTS.**

4 The Commissioner of Internal Revenue shall not pro-  
5 vide any performance award (including bonuses, step in-  
6 creases, and leave time) to senior-level executives of the  
7 Internal Revenue Service until such time as the Treasury  
8 Inspector General for Tax Administration certifies that  
9 the Internal Revenue Service has provided all documents,  
10 including all electronic communications, requested by the  
11 relevant congressional committees in due course of their  
12 investigation into the targeting of certain taxpayers who  
13 applied for designation as an organization described in  
14 section 501(c)(4) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986.
