A BILL

To designate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 25 South Oak Street in London, Ohio, as the “London Fallen Veterans Memorial Post Office”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. LONDON FALLEN VETERANS MEMORIAL POST**
4 **OFFICE.**

5 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
6 Postal Service located at 25 South Oak Street in London,
7 Ohio, shall be known and designated as the “London Fall-
8 en Veterans Memorial Post Office”.

1 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
2 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
3 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
4 be deemed to be a reference to the “London Fallen Vet-
5 erans Memorial Post Office”.
