## A BILL

To require the Administrator of the Environmental Protection Agency to provide adequate data, modeling, and support in the development of a State implementation plan under the Clean Air Act.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. PROVISION OF ADEQUATE DATA, MODELING,**  
4       **AND SUPPORT.**

5       For any rule or significant regulatory action of the  
6       Environmental Protection Agency relating to the require-  
7       ments of section 110 of the Clean Air Act (42 U.S.C.  
8       7410), the Administrator of the Environmental Protection

1 Agency shall provide in a timely manner, on the request  
2 of any State or other governmental entity involved in the  
3 development of a State implementation plan to comply  
4 with that rule or regulatory action—

5           (1) technical support;

6           (2) data, including integrated planning models  
7           and other modeling;

8           (3) clarification; and

9           (4) guidance.
