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# A BILL

To amend the Mni Wiconi Project Act of 1988 to facilitate completion of the Mni Wiconi Rural Water Supply System, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3   **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Mni Wiconi Project  
5   Act Amendments of 2013”.

1   **SEC. 2. OTHER AGENCY ASSISTANCE.**

2       The Mni Wiconi Project Act of 1988 (Public Law  
3   100–516; 102 Stat. 2566; 108 Stat. 4543) is amended  
4   by inserting after section 3B the following:

5   **“SEC. 3C. PLANS FOR COMPLETING THE OGLALA SIOUX**  
6                   **RURAL WATER SUPPLY SYSTEM, ROSEBUD**  
7                   **SIOUX RURAL WATER SYSTEM, AND LOWER**  
8                   **BRULE SIOUX RURAL WATER SYSTEM.**

9       “(a) PLANS FOR COMPLETION.—

10      “(1) IN GENERAL.—In consultation with the  
11     Oglala Sioux Tribe, the Rosebud Sioux Tribe, and  
12     the Lower Brule Sioux Tribe, as applicable, and the  
13     Federal agency heads listed in subsection (b)(1), the  
14     Secretary shall develop plans to complete the Oglala  
15     Sioux Rural Water Supply System, the Rosebud  
16     Sioux Rural Water System, and the Lower Brule  
17     Sioux Rural Water System.

18      “(2) CONTENTS.—The plan for each water sup-  
19     ply system described in paragraph (1) shall re-  
20     quire—

21       “(A) the completion of remaining compo-  
22     nents of the applicable system in accordance  
23     with the Final Engineering Report dated May  
24     1993;

25       “(B) the improvement, repair, and replace-  
26     ment of existing water systems; and

1               “(C) the transfer of those existing water  
2               systems to the United States, to be held in  
3               trust for the Oglala Sioux Tribe, the Rosebud  
4               Sioux Tribe, or the Lower Brule Sioux Tribe,  
5               as applicable, and made part of the applicable  
6               rural water system.

7               “(3) SUBMISSION TO CONGRESS.—Not later  
8               than 2 years after the date of enactment of this sec-  
9               tion, the Secretary shall submit to the Committee on  
10               Energy and Natural Resources of the Senate and  
11               the Committee on Natural Resources of the House  
12               of Representatives—

13               “(A) a copy of each plan developed under  
14               this subsection, including a schedule for full im-  
15               plementation of the plan that shall not exceed  
16               a period of 15 years after the date of enactment  
17               of this section;

18               “(B) a report that includes—

19               “(i) a description of the roles and re-  
20               sponsibilities of each of the heads of the  
21               Federal agencies listed in subsection (b)(1)  
22               (including the Commissioner of the Bureau  
23               of Reclamation) relating to the completion  
24               of the water supply systems, including with  
25               respect to the improvement, repair, and re-

1 placement of the existing water systems  
2 before and after transfer;

3 “(ii) the program authorities of each  
4 Federal agency listed in subsection (b)(1)  
5 and a description of how the heads of the  
6 Federal agencies will work together to  
7 complete and implement the plans; and

8 “(iii) the amount of funding and any  
9 other need the Secretary determines to be  
10 necessary to complete and implement the  
11 plans; and

12 “(C) as applicable, a description of the  
13 roles and responsibilities of the heads of other  
14 Federal agencies that have existing authorities  
15 to provide assistance to the Oglala Sioux Tribe,  
16 the Rosebud Sioux Tribe, or the Lower Brule  
17 Sioux Tribe.

18 “(b) INTERAGENCY AGREEMENTS.—

19 “(1) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other  
20 provision of law, the Secretary shall enter into  
21 agreements with the Administrator of the Environ-  
22 mental Protection Agency, the Secretary of Agri-  
23 culture, the Secretary of Health and Human Serv-  
24 ices, and the Secretary of Housing and Urban De-  
25 velopment—

1                 “(A) to fulfill the trust responsibility of the  
2                 United States; and

3                 “(B) to complete the Oglala Sioux Rural  
4                 Water Supply System, the Rosebud Sioux Rural  
5                 Water System, and the Lower Brule Sioux  
6                 Rural Water System in accordance with the  
7                 Final Engineering Report dated May 1993, in-  
8                 cluding the transfer of existing water systems,  
9                 *as set forth in the plans for completion developed*  
10                 *under subsection (a).*

11                 “(2) COOPERATION.—

12                 “(A) IN GENERAL.—The heads of the Fed-  
13                 eral agencies described in paragraph (1) shall  
14                 assist the Secretary in completing the Oglala  
15                 Sioux Rural Water Supply System, the Rosebud  
16                 Sioux Rural Water System, and the Lower  
17                 Brule Sioux Rural Water System pursuant to  
18                 sections 3(a), 3A(a), and 3B(a), respectively,  
19                 including by—

20                 “(i) improving, repairing, and replac-  
21                 ing existing water systems as set forth in  
22                 the plans developed under subsection (a);  
23                 and

1                     “(ii) constructing new rural water fa-  
2                     cilities, service lines, and other necessary  
3                     features.

4                     “(B) ADMINISTRATOR OF THE ENVIRON-  
5                     MENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY.—The Adminis-  
6                     trator of the Environmental Protection Agency  
7                     shall assist the Secretary in meeting the envi-  
8                     ronmental and safe drinking water needs of the  
9                     Pine Ridge Indian Reservation, the Rosebud In-  
10                    dian Reservation, and the Lower Brule Indian  
11                    Reservation, including through compliance with  
12                    the Safe Drinking Water Act (42 U.S.C. 300f  
13                    et seq.).

14                    “(C) SECRETARY OF HEALTH AND HUMAN  
15                    SERVICES.—The Secretary of Health and  
16                    Human Services shall assist the Secretary in  
17                    meeting the water supply and public health  
18                    needs of the Pine Ridge Indian Reservation, the  
19                    Rosebud Indian Reservation, and the Lower  
20                    Brule Indian Reservation, including through  
21                    compliance with the Act of August 5, 1954  
22                    (commonly known as the ‘Indian Sanitation Fa-  
23                    cilities Act’) (42 U.S.C. 2001 et seq.).

24                    “(D) SECRETARY OF HOUSING AND URBAN  
25                    DEVELOPMENT.—The Secretary of Housing and

1           Urban Development shall assist the Secretary  
2           by carrying out projects to connect houses that  
3           are eligible for funding from the Department of  
4           Housing and Urban Development on the res-  
5           ervations of the Oglala Sioux Tribe, the Rose-  
6           bud Sioux Tribe, and the Lower Brule Sioux  
7           Tribe, through plumbing, water pipes, appur-  
8           tenances, and interconnections to the Oglala  
9           Sioux Rural Water Supply System, the Rosebud  
10          Sioux Rural Water System, and the Lower  
11          Brule Sioux Rural Water System, respectively,  
12          to meet the water conservation standards of  
13          those water supply systems.

14         “(3) LIVESTOCK DISTRIBUTION SYSTEMS.—

15           “(A) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary and the  
16           Secretary of Agriculture shall, through the use  
17           of authorities of the Bureau of Indian Affairs  
18           and the Department of Agriculture, respec-  
19           tively, complete, during a period not to exceed  
20           15 years after the date of enactment of this  
21           section, the livestock distribution system for the  
22           Oglala Sioux Rural Water Supply System and  
23           the Rosebud Sioux Rural Water System, con-  
24           sistent with the Final Engineering Report dated  
25           May 1993.

1                 “(B) ADMINISTRATION.—For each water  
2 supply system described in subparagraph (A),  
3 the Secretary shall enter into agreements with  
4 the Secretary of Agriculture and the Director of  
5 the Bureau of Indian Affairs that set forth the  
6 specific responsibilities of each agency con-  
7 cerning the construction of the livestock dis-  
8 tribution systems.

9                 “(4) LEAD AGENCY.—The Department of the  
10 Interior, acting through the Bureau of Reclamation,  
11 shall act as the lead agency in carrying out this sec-  
12 tion.

13                 “(5) ADMINISTRATION.—

14                 “(A) IN GENERAL.—Each agency head  
15 shall carry out the duties of the agency head  
16 under this subsection out of amounts made  
17 available to the agency head under annual ap-  
18 propriations and existing ~~authority~~ authorities.

19                 “(B) AUTHORIZATION OF USE OF OTHER  
20 FEDERAL AGENCY FUNDS.—Amounts made  
21 available to agencies other than the Bureau of  
22 Reclamation may *also* be used to carry out this  
23 Act.

24                 “(C) ADDITIONAL FUNDING REQUESTS.—  
25 Nothing in this subsection prohibits the Oglala

1           Sioux Tribe, the Rosebud Sioux Tribe, or the  
2           Lower Brule Sioux Tribe from applying for,  
3           seeking, or obtaining amounts from the Federal  
4           agencies referred to in paragraph (1) for any  
5           other purpose.

6         “(c) UPGRADING STANDARDS FOR CONNECTING  
7 HOMES.—The Director of the Bureau of Indian Affairs  
8 shall, through the use of existing programs and annual  
9 appropriations, assist the Secretary in completing the Og-  
10 lala Sioux Rural Water Supply System, the Rosebud Sioux  
11 Rural Water System, and the Lower Brule Sioux Rural  
12 Water System by constructing, repairing, and upgrading  
13 plumbing fixtures, skirting, and other necessary features,  
14 such as septic tanks and drainfields, to ensure that houses  
15 within the service areas are able to meet the standards  
16 for connecting to those water systems.”.

17 **SEC. 3. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

18         (a) PLANNING, DESIGN, AND CONSTRUCTION.—Sec-  
19 tion 10(a) of the Mni Wiconi Project Act of 1988 (Public  
20 Law 100–516; 102 Stat. 2571; 108 Stat. 4545; 116 Stat.  
21 3033; 121 Stat. 1954) is amended—

22                 (1) in the first sentence, by striking “and  
23                 \$58,800,000 (based on October 1, 1997 price lev-  
24                 els)” and inserting “, \$58,800,000 (based on Octo-

1       ber 1, 1997 price levels), and \$14,308,000 (based on  
2       October 1, 2011 price levels);

3               (2) in the second sentence, by striking “2013”  
4       and inserting “2016”; and

5               (3) in the third sentence, by striking “and Oc-  
6       tober 1, 1997 (with respect to the \$58,800,000)”  
7       and inserting “, October 1, 1997 (with respect to  
8       the \$58,800,000), and October 1, 2011 (with respect  
9       to the \$14,308,000)”.

10       (b) OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF OGLALA  
11       SIOUX RURAL WATER SUPPLY SYSTEM, ROSEBUD SIOUX  
12       RURAL WATER SUPPLY SYSTEM, AND LOWER BRULE  
13       SIOUX WATER SUPPLY SYSTEM.—Section 10(b) of the  
14       Mni Wiconi Project Act of 1988 (Public Law 100–516;  
15       102 Stat. 2571; 108 Stat. 4545) is amended—

16               (1) in the first sentence, by striking “There  
17       are” and inserting the following:

18               “(1) OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE.—

19               “(A) IN GENERAL.—There are”;

20               (2) in the second sentence, by striking “The op-  
21       eration” and inserting the following:

22               “(B) WEST RIVER AND LYMAN-JONES  
23       RURAL WATER SYSTEMS.—

24               “(i) IN GENERAL.—The operation”;

1                             (3) in the third sentence, by striking “Such  
2 fee” and inserting the following:

3                             “(ii) FEE BASIS.—The fee described  
4 in clause (i)”;

5                             (4) in the fourth sentence, by striking “Such  
6 operation and maintenance payments” and inserting  
7 the following:

8                             “(iii) ADJUSTMENT OF PAYMENTS.—  
9                                 The operation and maintenance payments  
10 under this subparagraph”; and

11                             (5) by adding after paragraph (1) (as so des-  
12 ignated) the following:

13                             “(2) COMMUNITY WATER SYSTEMS UP-  
14 GRADES.—

15                             “(A) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 5 years  
16 after the date of enactment of the Mni Wiconi  
17 Project Act Amendments of 2013, each public  
18 or tribal water system that is in existence on  
19 the date of enactment of this paragraph shall  
20 be transferred to the applicable rural water  
21 supply system, to be held in trust by the United  
22 States for the benefit of the applicable Indian  
23 tribe, on the request of the Oglala Sioux Tribe,  
24 the Rosebud Sioux Tribe, or the Lower Brule

1 Sioux Tribe, as applicable, and the owner of the  
2 water system.

3           “(A) *IN GENERAL.*—After the date on which  
4 public or tribal water systems on the Pine Ridge  
5 Indian Reservation, the Rosebud Indian Res-  
6 ervation, and the Lower Brule Indian Reserva-  
7 tion that are in existence on the date of enact-  
8 ment of this paragraph have been brought up to  
9 the standards for the water systems established  
10 in the plans developed under section 3C(a), but  
11 not later than 15 years after the date of enact-  
12 ment of this paragraph, title to each of the water  
13 systems shall be transferred to the United States,  
14 to be held in trust for the benefit of the applica-  
15 ble Indian tribe, on the request of the Oglala  
16 Sioux Tribe, the Rosebud Sioux Tribe, or the  
17 Lower Brule Sioux Tribe, as applicable, and the  
18 owner of the water system.

19           “(B) *IMPROVEMENTS AND REPAIRS AND*  
20 *REPLACEMENT.*—The Secretary shall use  
21 amounts authorized to be appropriated under  
22 paragraph (1) for the improvement, repair, and  
23 replacement of any water system that is trans-  
24 ferred or proposed to be transferred proposed,  
25 by request of the owner of the water system, to

1           *be transferred and improved under subpara-*  
2           *graph (A).”.*
