Mr. REID (for himself and Mr. McCONNELL) submitted the following concurrent resolution; which was considered and agreed to

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for a conditional adjournment or recess of the Senate and an adjournment of the House of Representatives.

1 *Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives*
2 *concurring)*, That when the Senate recesses or adjourns
3 on any day from Friday, March 22, 2013 through Tues-
4 day, March 26, 2013, on a motion offered pursuant to
5 this concurrent resolution by its Majority Leader or his
6 designee, it stand recessed or adjourned until 12:00 noon
7 on Monday, April 8, 2013, or such other time on that day
8 as may be specified by its Majority Leader or his designee
9 in the motion to recess or adjourn, or until the time of
10 any reassembly pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent

1 resolution, whichever occurs first; and that when the
2 House adjourns on Monday, March 25, 2013, on a motion
3 offered pursuant to this concurrent resolution by its Ma-
4 jority Leader or his designee, it stand adjourned until 2:00
5 p.m. on Tuesday, April 9, 2013, or until the time of any
6 reassembly pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent resolu-
7 tion, whichever occurs first.

8 SEC. 2. The Majority Leader of the Senate and the
9 Speaker of the House, or their respective designees, acting
10 jointly after consultation with the Minority Leader of the
11 Senate and the Minority Leader of the House, shall notify
12 the Members of the Senate and House, respectively, to re-
13 assemble at such place and time as they may designate
14 if, in their opinion, the public interest shall warrant it.
