Mr. DURBIN submitted the following concurrent resolution; which was considered and agreed to

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for a conditional adjournment or recess of the Senate and an adjournment of the House of Representatives.

1 *Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives*
2 *concurring)*, That when the Senate recesses or adjourns
3 on any day from Friday, December 20, 2013, through
4 Tuesday, December 31, 2013, on a motion offered pursu-
5 ant to this concurrent resolution by its Majority Leader
6 or his designee, it stand adjourned until 11:45 a.m. on
7 Friday, January 3, 2014, or until the time of any re-
8 assembly pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent resolu-
9 tion, whichever occurs first; and that when the House ad-
10 journs on any legislative day from Monday, December 23,

1 2013, through Tuesday, December 31, 2013, on a motion
2 offered pursuant to this concurrent resolution by its Ma-
3 jority Leader or his designee, it stand adjourned until
4 11:00 a.m. on Friday, January 3, 2014, or until the time
5 of any reassembly pursuant to section 3 of this concurrent
6 resolution, whichever occurs first.

7 SEC. 2. (a) The Majority Leader of the Senate or his
8 designee, after consultation with the Minority Leader of
9 the Senate, shall notify the Members of the Senate to reas-
10 semble at such place and time he may designate if, in his
11 opinion, the public interest shall warrant it.

12 (b) After reassembling pursuant to subsection (a),
13 when the Senate adjourns on a motion offered pursuant
14 to this subsection by the Majority Leader or his designee,
15 the Senate shall again stand adjourned pursuant to the
16 first section of this concurrent resolution.

17 SEC. 3. (a) The Speaker or his designee, after con-
18 sultation with the Minority Leader of the House, shall no-
19 tify the Members of the House to reassemble at such place
20 and time he may designate if, in his opinion, the public
21 interest shall warrant it.

22 (b) After reassembling pursuant to subsection (a),
23 when the House adjourns on a motion offered pursuant
24 to this subsection by the Speaker or his designee, the

- 1 House shall again stand adjourned pursuant to the first
- 2 section of this concurrent resolution.
