7                (a) IN GENERAL.—The rotunda of the Capitol is au-  
8        thorized to be used on July 9, 2014, for a ceremony to

1 award the Congressional Gold Medal to the next of kin  
2 or personal representative of Raoul Wallenberg in recogni-  
3 tion of his achievements and heroic actions during the  
4 Holocaust.

5 (b) PREPARATIONS.—Physical preparations for the  
6 ceremony described in subsection (a) shall be carried out  
7 in accordance with such conditions as the Architect of the  
8 Capitol may prescribe.
