JOINT RESOLUTION

Amending title 36, United States Code, to designate the last Friday in April as Arbor Day.

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ARBOR DAY.**

4 Chapter 1 of title 36, United States Code, is amended
5 by adding at the end the following:

6 **“§ 145. Arbor Day**

7 “(a) DESIGNATION.—The last Friday in April is
8 Arbor Day.

1 “(b) PURPOSE.—The purpose of Arbor Day is to cele-
2 brate the importance of stewardship by encouraging the
3 planting of and caring for trees.

4 “(c) PROCLAMATION.—The President is requested to
5 issue each year a proclamation inviting the people of the
6 United States to observe Arbor Day with appropriate cere-
7 monies and activities, including the planting of trees, on
8 the last Friday in April or another seasonally appropriate
9 day.”.

10 **SEC. 2. CONFORMING AMENDMENT.**

11 The table of sections for chapter 1 of title 36, United
12 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-
13 lowing:

“145. Arbor Day.”.
