CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring),*

3 **SECTION 1. USE OF CAPITOL GROUNDS FOR EVENT TO**
4 **COMMEMORATE 20TH ANNIVERSARY OF MIL-**
5 **LION MAN MARCH.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Million Man March, Inc. 2015 (in
7 this resolution referred to as the “sponsor”) shall be

1 permitted to sponsor a public event on the Capitol
2 Grounds to commemorate the 20th Anniversary of the
3 Million Man March (in this resolution referred to as the
4 “event”).

5 (b) DATE OF EVENT.—The event shall be held on
6 October 10, 2015, or on such other date as the Speaker
7 of the House of Representatives and the Committee on
8 Rules and Administration of the Senate jointly designate.

9 **SEC. 2. TERMS AND CONDITIONS.**

10 (a) IN GENERAL.—Under conditions to be prescribed
11 by the Architect of the Capitol and the Capitol Police
12 Board, the event shall be—

13 (1) free of admission charge and open to the
14 public; and

15 (2) arranged not to interfere with the needs of
16 Congress.

17 (b) EXPENSES AND LIABILITIES.—The sponsor shall
18 assume full responsibility for all expenses and liabilities
19 incident to all activities associated with the event.

20 **SEC. 3. EVENT PREPARATIONS.**

21 Subject to the approval of the Architect of the Cap-
22 itol, the sponsor is authorized to erect upon the Capitol
23 Grounds such stage, sound amplification devices, and
24 other related structures and equipment, as may be re-
25 quired for the event.

1 **SEC. 4. ADDITIONAL ARRANGEMENTS.**

2 The Architect of the Capitol and the Capitol Police
3 Board are authorized to make any such additional ar-
4 rangements that may be required to carry out the event.

5 **SEC. 5. ENFORCEMENT OF RESTRICTIONS.**

6 The Capitol Police Board shall provide for enforce-
7 ment of the restrictions in section 5104(c) of title 40,
8 United States Code, concerning sales, advertisements, dis-
9 plays, and solicitations on the Capitol Grounds, as well
10 as other restrictions applicable to the Capitol Grounds, in
11 connection with the event.
