1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Small Business Invest-
5 ment Company Capital Act of 2015”.

6 **SEC. 2. INCREASED LIMITATIONS ON LEVERAGE FOR MUL-**
7 **TIPLE LICENSES UNDER COMMON CONTROL.**

8 Section 303(b)(2)(B) of the Small Business Invest-
9 ment Act of 1958 (15 U.S.C. 683(b)(2)(B)) is amended
10 by striking “\$225,000,000” and inserting
11 “\$350,000,000”.
