A BILL

To prohibit officers and employees of the Internal Revenue Service from using personal email accounts to conduct official business.

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 *This Act may be cited as the “IRS Email Trans-*
5 *parency Act”.*

6 **SEC. 2. IRS EMPLOYEES PROHIBITED FROM USING PER-**
7 **SONAL EMAIL ACCOUNTS FOR OFFICIAL BUSI-**
8 **NESS.**

9 *No officer or employee of the Internal Revenue Service*
10 *may use a personal email account to conduct any official*
11 *business of the Government.*
