AN ACT

To repeal the provisions of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act providing for the Independent Payment Advisory Board.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Protecting Seniors’
3 Access to Medicare Act of 2015”.

4 **SEC. 2. REPEAL OF THE INDEPENDENT PAYMENT ADVI-
5 SORY BOARD.**

6 Effective as of the enactment of the Patient Protec-
7 tion and Affordable Care Act (Public Law 111–148), sec-
8 tions 3403 and 10320 of such Act (including the amend-
9 ments made by such sections) are repealed, and any provi-
10 sion of law amended by such sections is hereby restored
11 as if such sections had not been enacted into law.

12 **SEC. 3. RESCINDING FUNDING AMOUNTS FOR PREVENTION
13 AND PUBLIC HEALTH FUND.**

14 Section 4002(b) of the Patient Protection and Af-
15 fordable Care Act (42 U.S.C. 300u–11(b)) is amended—

16 (1) in paragraph (2), by striking “2017” and
17 inserting “2016”;

18 (2) in paragraph (5)—

19 (A) by striking “2022” and inserting
20 “2026”; and

21 (B) by redesignating such paragraph as
22 paragraph (7); and

23 (3) by striking paragraphs (3) and (4) and in-
24 serting the following:

25 “(3) for fiscal year 2017, \$390,000,000;

1 “(4) for each of fiscal years 2018 and 2019,
2 \$487,000,000;

3 “(5) for each of fiscal years 2020 and 2021,
4 \$585,000,000;

5 “(6) for each of fiscal years 2022 through
6 2025, \$780,000,000; and”.
