A BILL

To amend the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act to clarify the maintenance of effort requirement for local educational agencies.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXCEPTION TO MAINTENANCE OF EFFORT RE-**
4 **QUIREMENT FOR LOCAL EDUCATIONAL**
5 **AGENCIES.**

6 Section 613(a)(2)(B) of the Individuals with Disabil-
7 ities Education Act (20 U.S.C. 1413(a)(2)(B)) is amend-
8 ed—

9 (1) in clause (iii)(III), by striking “or” at the
10 end;

1 (2) in clause (iv), by striking the period at the
2 end and inserting “; or”; and

3 (3) by adding at the end the following new
4 clause:

5 “(v) the reduction of expenditures for
6 employment related benefits provided to
7 special education personnel such as pay,
8 retirement contributions, annual and sick
9 leave, and health and life insurance.”.

10 **SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

11 The amendments made by section 1 shall take effect
12 beginning fiscal year 2016.
