A BILL

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Bureau Advisory Com-
5 mission Transparency Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. APPLICATION OF FACa.**

7 Section 1013 of the Consumer Financial Protection
8 Act of 2010 (12 U.S.C. 5493) is amended by adding at
9 the end the following:

10 “(h) APPLICATION OF FACa.—Notwithstanding any
11 provision of the Federal Advisory Committee Act (5
12 U.S.C. App.), such Act shall apply to each advisory com-
13 mittee of the Bureau and each subcommittee of such an
14 advisory committee.”.
