A BILL

To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to repeal the individual health insurance mandate.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Patient Freedom Act
5 of 2014”.

6 **SEC. 2. REPEAL OF INDIVIDUAL HEALTH INSURANCE MAN-**
7 **DATE.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 5000A of the Internal
9 Revenue Code of 1986 is amended by adding at the end
10 the following new subsection:

1 “(h) TERMINATION.—This section shall not apply
2 with respect to any month beginning after December 31,
3 2013.”.

4 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
5 subsection (a) shall apply to taxable years ending after
6 December 31, 2013.

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
