## AN ACT

To authorize a Wall of Remembrance as part of the Korean War Veterans Memorial and to allow certain private contributions to fund that Wall of Remembrance.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2       This Act may be cited as the “Korean War Veterans  
3 Memorial Wall of Remembrance Act of 2016”.

4 **SEC. 2. WALL OF REMEMBRANCE.**

5       Section 1 of the Act titled “An Act to authorize the  
6 erection of a memorial on Federal Land in the District  
7 of Columbia and its environs to honor members of the  
8 Armed Forces of the United States who served in the Ko-  
9 rean War”, approved October 25, 1986 (Public Law 99–  
10 572), is amended by adding at the end the following:

11       “Such memorial shall include a Wall of Remembrance,  
12 which shall be constructed without the use of Federal  
13 funds. The American Battle Monuments Commission shall  
14 request and consider design recommendations from the  
15 Korean War Veterans Memorial Foundation, Inc. for the  
16 establishment of the Wall of Remembrance. The Wall of  
17 Remembrance shall include—

18               “(1) a list by name of members of the Armed  
19 Forces of the United States who died in theatre in  
20 the Korean War;

21               “(2) the number of members of the Armed  
22 Forces of the United States who, in regards to the  
23 Korean War—

24                       “(A) were wounded in action;

25                       “(B) are listed as missing in action; or

26                       “(C) were prisoners of war; and

1           “(3) the number of members of the Korean  
2           Augmentation to the United States Army, the Re-  
3           public of Korea Armed Forces, and the other na-  
4           tions of the United Nations Command who, in re-  
5           gards to the Korean War—

6                   “(A) were killed in action;

7                   “(B) were wounded in action;

8                   “(C) are listed as missing in action; or

9                   “(D) were prisoners of war.”.
