A BILL

To provide that no funds appropriated or otherwise made available may be used to implement, administer, carry out, or enforce certain memoranda related to immigration.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Defund Amnesty Act
5 of 2015”.

1 **SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON THE USE OF FUNDS FOR CERTAIN**
2 **PURPOSES RELATED TO IMMIGRATION.**

3 No funds appropriated or otherwise made available
4 may be used to implement, administer, carry out, or en-
5 force the following policy memoranda:

6 (1) The memoranda issued by the Secretary of
7 Homeland Security on November 20, 2014.

8 (2) The memoranda issued by the President on
9 November 21, 2014, including—

10 (A) the memorandum entitled “Creating
11 Welcoming Communities and Fully Integrating
12 Immigrants and Refugees”; and

13 (B) the memorandum entitled “Modern-
14 izing and Streamlining the U.S. Immigrant
15 Visa System for the 21st Century”.

16 (3) Any similar memorandum issued after No-
17 vember 21, 2014.

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
