Mr. HUIZENG of Michigan (for himself and Mrs. CAROLYN B. MALONEY of New York) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Financial Services

A BILL

To amend design and content requirements for certain gold
and silver coins, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Bullion and Collectible
5 Coin Production Efficiency and Cost Savings Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS.**

7 Title 31, United States Code, is amended—

8 (1) in section 5112—

9 (A) in subsection (q)—

1 (i) by striking paragraphs (3) and (8);

2 and

3 (ii) by redesignating paragraphs (4),

4 (5), (6), and (7) as paragraphs (3), (4),

5 (5), and (6), respectively;

6 (B) in subsection (t)(6)(B), by striking

7 “90 percent silver and 10 percent copper” and

8 inserting “not less than 90 percent silver”; and

9 (C) in subsection (v)—

10 (i) in paragraph (1), by striking

11 “Subject to” and all that follows through

12 “the Secretary shall” and inserting “The

13 Secretary shall”;

14 (ii) in paragraph (2)(A), by striking

15 “The Secretary” and inserting “To the

16 greatest extent possible, the Secretary”;

17 (iii) in paragraph (5), by inserting

18 after “may issue” the following: “collect-

19 ible versions of”; and

20 (iv) by striking paragraph (8); and

21 (2) in section 5132(a)(2)(B)(i), by striking “90

22 percent silver and 10 percent copper” and inserting

23 “not less than 90 percent silver”.

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
