A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to permit the centralized reporting of veteran enrollment by certain groups, districts, and consortiums of educational institutions.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CENTRALIZED REPORTING OF VETERAN EN-**
4 **ROLLMENT BY CERTAIN GROUPS, DISTRICTS,**
5 **AND CONSORTIUMS OF EDUCATIONAL INSTI-**
6 **TUTIONS.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 3684(a) of title 38,
8 United States Code, is amended—

1 (1) in paragraph (1), by inserting “32, 33,”
2 after “31,”; and

3 (2) by adding at the end the following new
4 paragraph:

5 “(4) For purposes of this subsection, the term ‘edu-
6 cational institution’ may include a group, district, or con-
7 sortium of separately accredited educational institutions
8 located in the same State that are organized in a manner
9 that facilitates the centralized reporting of the enrollments
10 in such group, district, or consortium of institutions.”.

11 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendments made by
12 subsection (a) shall apply with respect to reports sub-
13 mitted on or after the date of the enactment of this Act.
