1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE. 2 This Act may be cited as the "Mental Health First 3 Aid Act of 2016". SEC. 2. MENTAL HEALTH AWARENESS TRAINING GRANTS. 5 Section 520J of the Public Health Service Act (42 6 U.S.C. 290bb-41) is amended— 7 (1) in the section heading, by inserting "**MEN-**TAL HEALTH AWARENESS" before "TRAINING"; 8 9 and 10 (2) in subsection (b)— 11 (A) in the subsection heading, by striking "ILLNESS" and inserting "HEALTH"; 12 13 (B) in paragraph (1), by inserting ", veterans, law enforcement, and other categories of 14 15 individuals, as determined by the Secretary," after "emergency services personnel"; 16 17 (C) in paragraph (5)— 18 (i) in the matter preceding subpara-19 graph (A), by striking "to" and inserting "for evidence-based programs that provide 20 21 education to teachers, personnel, and other 22 categories of individuals described in para-23 graph (1) on at least"; and

(ii) by striking subparagraphs (A)

through (C) and inserting the following:
