A BILL

To require the Secretary of State to provide relevant Foreign Service officers with training related to medical graduates in the countries in which such officers are serving, and for other purposes.

3 **SECTION 1. TRAINING FOR FOREIGN SERVICE OFFICERS.**

4 The Secretary of State shall provide to relevant For-
5 eign Service officers training related to medical graduates
6 and medical graduate programs in the countries in which
7 such officers are serving. Such training shall be part of

1 the training provided to such officers under section 701
2 of the Foreign Service Act of 1980 (22 U.S.C. 4021).

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
