## A BILL

To require the Administrator of the Environmental Protection Agency to appoint a coordinator for issues relating to harmful algal blooms in the Great Lakes, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. GREAT LAKES HARMFUL ALGAL BLOOM COOR-**  
4 **DINATOR.**

5 The Administrator of the Environmental Protection  
6 Agency, acting as chair of the Great Lakes Interagency

1 Task Force, shall appoint a coordinator to work with ap-  
2 propriate Federal agencies and State, local, tribal, and  
3 foreign governments to address the issue of harmful algal  
4 blooms in the Great Lakes.
