A BILL

To provide for the consideration and submission of site and design proposals for the National Liberty Memorial approved for establishment in the District of Columbia.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “National Liberty Me-
5 morial Clarification Act of 2015”.

6 **SEC. 2. COMPLIANCE WITH CERTAIN STANDARDS FOR COM-**

7 **MEMORATIVE WORKS IN ESTABLISHMENT OF**

8 **NATIONAL LIBERTY MEMORIAL.**

9 Section 2860(c) of the Military Construction Author-
10 ization Act for Fiscal Year 2013 (division B of Public Law
11 112–239; 40 U.S.C. 8903 note) is amended by striking
12 the period at the end and inserting the following: “, except
13 that, under subsections (a)(2) and (b) of section 8905, the
14 Secretary of Agriculture, rather than the Secretary of the
15 Interior or the Administrator of General Services, shall be
16 responsible for the consideration of site and design pro-
17 posals and the submission of such proposals on behalf of
18 the sponsor to the Commission of Fine Arts and National
19 Capital Planning Commission”.
