4	Notwithstanding the time period described in section				
5	13 of the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C. 806) that would				
6	otherwise apply to the Federal Energy Regulatory Com				
7	mission project numbered 12429, the Federal Energy				
8	Regulatory Commission (referred to in this section as the				
9	"Commission") shall, at the request of the licensee for the				
10	project, and after reasonable notice and in accordance				
11	with the procedures of the Commission under that section				
12	reinstate the license and extend the time period during				
13	which the licensee is required to commence construction				
14	of project works for the 3-year period beginning on th				
15	date of enactment of this Act.
