AN ACT

To amend the Fair Credit Reporting Act to clarify the ability
to request consumer reports in certain cases to establish
and enforce child support payments and awards.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Child Support Assist-
3 ance Act of 2015”.

4 **SEC. 2. REQUESTS FOR CONSUMER REPORTS BY STATE OR**
5 **LOCAL CHILD SUPPORT ENFORCEMENT**
6 **AGENCIES.**

7 Paragraph (4) of section 604(a) of the Fair Credit
8 Reporting Act (15 U.S.C. 1681b(a)(4)) is amended—

9 (1) in subparagraph (A), by striking “or deter-
10 mining the appropriate level of such payments” and
11 inserting “, determining the appropriate level of
12 such payments, or enforcing a child support order,
13 award, agreement, or judgment”;

14 (2) in subparagraph (B)—

15 (A) by striking “paternity” and inserting
16 “parentage”; and

17 (B) by adding “and” at the end;

18 (3) by striking subparagraph (C); and

19 (4) by redesignating subparagraph (D) as sub-
20 paragraph (C).
