3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF CREDIT FOR ENERGY-EFFI-**
4 **CIENT EXISTING HOMES.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Paragraph (2) of section 25C(g)
6 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 is amended by strik-
7 ing “December 31, 2014.” and inserting “December 31,
8 2015”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 this section shall apply to property placed in service after
3 December 31, 2014.

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
