A BILL

To designate Union Station in Washington, DC, as the “Harry S. Truman Union Station”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. HARRY S. TRUMAN UNION STATION.**

4 (a) DESIGNATION.—Union Station, located at 405
5 Massachusetts Avenue, NE., Washington, DC, shall be
6 known and designated as the “Harry S. Truman Union
7 Station”.

8 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
9 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United

1 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
2 be deemed to be a reference to the “Harry S. Truman
3 Union Station”.
