A BILL

To amend the Water Resources Development Act of 1996 to deauthorize the Ten Mile Creek Water Preserve Area Critical Restoration Project.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PROJECT DEAUTHORIZATION.**

4 Section 528(b)(3) of the Water Resources Develop-
5 ment Act of 1996 (Public Law 104–303; 110 Stat. 3768)
6 is amended by adding at the end the following:

7 “(E) PROJECT DEAUTHORIZATION.—

8 “(i) IN GENERAL.—The project identi-
9 fied as the ‘Ten Mile Creek Water Pre-

1 serve Area Critical Restoration Project’,
2 carried out pursuant to this paragraph,
3 shall no longer be authorized as a Federal
4 project upon execution of a transfer agree-
5 ment between the Secretary and the South
6 Florida Water Management District.

7 “(ii) REQUIREMENT.—A transfer
8 agreement referred to in clause (i) shall re-
9 quire that the South Florida Water Man-
10 agement District operate the transferred
11 project as an environmental restoration
12 project to provide water storage and water
13 treatment options.”.

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
